#### **Preparing Show Entry**

- All quilts must have a **label** on the back lower right-hand corner (the lower right with the back of the quilt facing you) that includes your name and phone number.
- Each entry must be delivered in its own **pillowcase**. Each pillowcase must have a label securely attached with your name, phone number, and name of quilt.

- Sunday, April 16 1 pm to 3 pm

# Quilt Pickup/Return

- Saturday, April 29, 2023, 4:30 to 5:30 pm at the Armory after the quilt show.
- You or your representative must present your receipt to receive your guilt.
- You or your representative can not take your guilt off the display racks.

# Judging will take place on Friday, April 21, 2023.

- The quilt show committee reserves the right to re-categorize entries, or not display inappropriate entries (soiled, damaged, misrepresented, etc.)
- At the judge's discretion, all ribbons may not be awarded.
