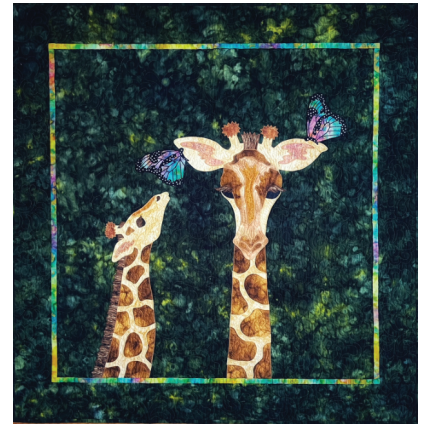


Supply List for My Favorite Earrings or Mama Llama Love Workshop

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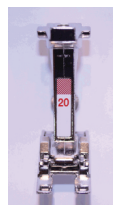
- **Sewing Machine** in good working order (You must know how to thread your machine, wind a bobbin and choose stitches on your machine. If you think you may have any questions regarding your machine, please bring your manual.)
- Open toed appliqué foot (see info below)
- Bobbins
- Thread in colors to match your fabrics
- Applique Press Sheet (This is a MUST. It will make your applique process so much easier.)
- Pencil or pen
- Scissors for paper and fabric
- 3 yards of Heat 'n Bond Lite Fusible Web - *You may be tempted to use another type of fusible web that you already have on hand. **Please use Heat 'n Bond LITE for this workshop.** I will explain the differences in fusibles during the class. If you prefer to use something else after the workshop, that is fine. But please, humor me, I don't ask for much!*
- Extension tray for your machine (*if you have one*)
- White computer paper for stabilizer (approximately 10 sheets)
- Two fabrics, one light, one dark, 10" x 7" color doesn't matter, to practice stitches.
- **My Favorite Earrings - \$11, or Mama Llama Love - \$11** patterns by **Hissyfitz Designs** may be ordered from Sandy's website, either hard copy, which will be mailed to you or PDF, which you may print at home.



Check back of pattern for fabric requirements.

You have the *option* to purchase a kit which includes the fabrics for either of these designs. The kit is **not laser cut but provides fabrics needed for each of the pieces in your chosen pattern. You will need to provide your own background fabric, flange fabric, Heat 'n Bond Lite, batting, and backing fabric.

Kit fee is \$25



This is a photo of an open toed applique foot. The foot for your machine may not look exactly like this, but should have clear visibility between the two "toes" of the foot. **If you do not have a foot similar to this, it is TOTALLY worth investing in one before the class.**
