Set Up on Thursday—Lead Karen Guinn

May Include: Transporting material and equipment from storage facility, arranging tables and chairs, installing signage, erecting racks, hanging quilts with labels and ribbons.

Take Down on Saturday

May include: Stowing tables and chairs, retrieving and repacking quilts, removing all SIQ materials, packing, disassembling racks, and transporting all SIQ materials and equipment back to storage facility.

Admissions on Friday and Saturday—Leads Cindy Hunt and Bobbie Elder

May include: Welcome attendees, collect admission fees, provide orientation to show layout, answer questions, give information about LC Store, Viewers Choice voting, and participating vendors.

Note: First Responders, Military Personnel, and Medical Personnel will get \$1 off admission. Also those with \$1 off bookmarks.

Judging Support, a week prior to show—Lead Lynn O'Neal

Assist quilt judge in examining the quilt show entries submitted for judging. May include: collecting, organizing, and transporting the quilts, lifting and handling the quilts for the judge, taking notes, and organizing and packing quilts for transportation to the quilt show venue.

White Glove on Friday and Saturday—Leads Cindy Hunt and Bobbie Elder

Walking about the facility showing off the reverse side of quilts and discouraging visitors from touching the quilts, answering questions about the show and the SIQ guild. White gloves are provided.

Quilt Raffle on Friday and Saturday—Leads Lee Hix & Shelby Berry

Monitor the sale and collection of quilt raffle tickets sold during the show. At the end of the show, these volunteers conduct the drawing, notify the winner and make the presentation, photograph the winner with the raffle quilt, if possible, and arrange for shipment.

Raffle Baskets on Friday and Saturday—Lead Mary Ann Voegtle

May include: Arranging tables for gift baskets, sell and collect raffle tickets, monitor tables and ticket collection boxes, monitor the Viewers Choice box. At end of show, conduct a public drawing, notify winners, and make award presentations.

Low Country Store on Friday, and Saturday—Leads Donna McCoy & Andrea West

May include: Arranging the store, monitor the tables displaying items for sale, assist attendees who are shopping, make sales and collect funds. At the end of the show, assist in collecting and packing unsold items for return to the guild.
